# 2016 Fall Registration Information

Dear Players/Parents,

We are the Palos Verdes region (Region 10) of the American Youth Soccer Organization (AYSO). We provide year-round recreational and competitive youth soccer programs that are enjoyed by three-year olds (Playtime Adventure program) all the way up to 19 year olds (U19). We welcome players from the Palos Verdes Peninsula and surrounding communities. We are a 100% volunteer organization.

## How Do I Register For 2016 Palos Verdes AYSO Fall Soccer?

All players (both new and returning) must go to <a href="www.eayso.org">www.eayso.org</a>, register and pay online by credit card. We no longer accept checks or cash.

As explained below, some players can completely register online at <a href="www.eayso.org">www.eayso.org</a>. Some players need to take their registration form and attend an in-person registration on April 16 or May 21.

#### Which Players Are Eligible For Complete Online 2016 Palos Verdes AYSO Fall Registration?

All <u>returning</u> players in divisions U10, U11, U12, U14, U16 and U19 can register at <u>www.eayso.org</u> and pay online by credit card to complete their registration without attending an in-person registration (see following page for instruction for rules on attending an in person registration event). This is all you need to do to pay and register. However, if the player is requesting to play up a division, you must let us know by writing it at the top of the player form with the requested division and mailing the form to us at: Palos Verdes AYSO, PO Box 2302, PVP, CA 90274.

All <u>returning head</u> coaches in divisions U7 to U19 can register their children at <u>www.eayso.org</u> and pay online by credit card to complete their registration without attending an in person registration. This is all you need to do to pay and register. However, if the player is requesting to play up a division, you must let us know by writing it at the top of the player form with the requested division and mailing the form to us at: Palos Verdes AYSO, PO Box 2302, PVP, CA 90274.

#### How Do I Pay Online By Credit Card?

You pay by credit card at <a href="www.eayso.org">www.eayso.org</a> after you complete the registration for <a href="all your children">all your children</a> at <a href="www.eayso.org">www.eayso.org</a> If you are registering more than one child, you need to register all children first and then pay by credit card for all your children <a href="collectively">collectively</a> so you can receive the sibling discount that is offered between March 1 and May 31.

#### Which Players Must Attend An In Person Registration For 2016 Palos Verdes Fall AYSO?

- 1) All players in the U5 and U6 divisions must register in person on April 16 or May 21.
- 2) All players in the U7 to U9 divisions whose parent is not a <u>returning head</u> coach must register in person on April 16 or May 21.
- 3) All players who have not previously played in Palos Verdes AYSO must register in person on April 21 or May 21.

# How Do I Register In Person?

All parents/players can register in person by 1) registering their children on <a href="www.eayso.org">www.eayso.org</a>, 2) paying online by credit card, 3) printing a copy of the player registration form <a href="mailto:and">and</a> the proof of credit card payment and 4) bringing both these forms to one of our in person registrations. If you are a U5 player or a new player in our region, you <a href="mailto:must">must</a> also bring a copy of birth certificate, passport, or other government ID for the player(s) that you are registering.

# When and Where Are The In Person Registrations For 2016 Palos Verdes AYSO Fall Soccer?

- Saturday, April 16, Noon to 4 pm, Hesse Park Community Center ("Hesse Park")
   29301 Hawthorne Blvd, RPV, EARLY BIRD DISCOUNT (\$145 first child /\$130 siblings)
- Saturday, May 21, Noon to 4 pm, Hesse Park, DISCOUNT (\$175 first child /\$160 siblings)

**U7 through U14 players registered after June 1 will be placed on a waiting list.** These players will only be placed on a team if there are openings in their division. Regular Registration Fee after May 31 will increase to **\$225 with no sibling discount** 

#### When Can I Start To Register On Line At www.eayso.org and How Much Is Registration?

Fall registration for everyone begins on March 1, 2016 at www.eayso.org.

The price for registration for all players who register at <a href="www.eayso.org">www.eayso.org</a> and pay online by credit card between March 1, 2016 and April 16, 2016 is \$145 for the first child and \$130 for each sibling.

The price for registration for all players who register at <a href="www.eayso.org">www.eayso.org</a> and pay online by credit card between April 17, 2016 and May 31, 2016 is \$175 for the first child and \$160 for each sibling.

The price for registration for all players who register at <a href="www.eayso.org">www.eayso.org</a> and pay online by credit card after May 31, 2016 is \$225 per player with no sibling discount. After May 31, the player is not guaranteed a spot on a team and will be placed on a waiting list.

**Remember:** Make sure you register all your children first at <a href="www.eayso.org">www.eayso.org</a> and then pay by credit card collectively so you can receive the sibling discount (if you register by May 31, 2016)

## How Do I Prepare a Player Registration Form?

The eAYSO website provides simplified log in procedures and step-by-step instructions to guide you through the registration process for players and volunteers. If you registered your child last year at <a href="https://www.eayso.org">www.eayso.org</a>, your family information will already be entered on the player form.

The information you enter at <a href="www.eayso.org">www.eayso.org</a> becomes your child's registration form, which is also his or her medical release. Please make sure you enter accurately/update all contact information for both parents, all emergency contacts, the name of your child's school, and all e-mail addresses.

IMPORTANT!!: The online registration process will lead you through multiple pages. When you reach the page that displays the completed Player Registration Form and has a box at the top that provides instructions on electronic signatures, it is important that you scroll down, check the box marked "I agree to use an electronic signature", type in your name in the signature box, and click "Continue". Then you must click "Submit" on the bottom of the next page to submit the Player Application Form. After you have completed the steps to register all of your children, check the boxes of all of the children you have registered and click on Online Payments to pay the registration fee and complete the registration process.

# What Do I Bring to the In Person Registration?

- 1. One printed copy of your player registration form for each child from www.eayso.org
- One printed copy of your proof of credit card payment for all children from <a href="www.eayso.org">www.eayso.org</a>.
  If you are signing up multiple children, make sure you register all children first and then pay online for all children at the same time to receive sibling discount.
- 3. For players who have not played in Palos Verdes AYSO, you <u>must</u> bring proof of your child's age to an in-person registration by a birth certificate, passport, or other government issued ID.

## What Is Your Refund Policy?

All refunds for fall soccer must be requested by June 15, 2016. There are no refunds after June 15.

# What If I Need Help Registering Or If I have Questions?

All players/parents can come to our in person registrations on April 16 or May 21 for help. We will have computers and printers and volunteers to help you register and answer all your questions.

The following table describes how we'll organize the age divisions for the AYSO Fall 2016 season.

# Can I Play Up Or Down A Division?

Players may play up one division only with the approval of the Regional Commissioner. <u>You must write this request to play up at the top of the player form with the requested division and submit to us or else we will not know about it.</u> No player may play down a division.
