Palos Verdes AYSO

Welcome to the Palos Verdes region (Region 10) of the American Youth Soccer Organization (AYSO) located on the beautiful Palos Verdes Peninsula. We offer recreational and competitive soccer programs year-round to boys and girls ages 4 to 19 years old.

Our core philosophies for fun and fair soccer are:

Our primary fall season is held on Saturdays from September to December. In 2016, nearly 2,500 children played soccer in our fall program on the finest quality fields located throughout the Peninsula. We also offer single-year age divisions for many divisions so that children can enjoy soccer with their classmates.

2017 Fall Registrations

In 2017, AYSO will be changing age group divisions to be based on calendar year birthdays (January 1 to December 31) and changing the age group designations from "Under X(AGE)" (e.g. U10) to "X(AGE) and Under" (e.g. 10U) divisions. A more detailed description on this change and how it may impact your child's division can be found on this website.

Players can begin to register online for fall soccer starting on March 20, 2017 at <http://ayso.bluesombrero.com/region10>. If you are a returning player in the 10U to 18U division, you can pay and register completely online. If you have not played in our Region before or if you are in the 5U to 9U divisions, then you need to pay online, but you also need to attend our in-person registration to register. This is because we need volunteers in the younger divisions. We do allow returning coaches in 7U to 9U to pay and register completely online.

In-Person Registration for our primary 2017 fall season will be held on Saturday April 29 and May 20, 2017, at Hesse Park Community Center, 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard, Rancho Palos Verdes. Check out our 2017 Fall Registration Information for pricing and specific details. Remember, you must pre-register your child online with the AYSO national database located at <http://ayso.bluesombrero.com/region10>. If you have any questions or if you are having trouble registering online, please attend one of our in-person registrations. We will have computers and printers and volunteers there to help you register.

In March, we mail to families whose children played in our 2016 fall program important registration information. Look for a small packet again this year. All basic information will be posted on this website

in order to save resources. In addition, we'll distribute flyers through PVPUSD schools and we'll send e-mail messages as a reminder of our registrations and our upcoming events.

Palos Verdes AYSO Opportunities

We also offer a popular recreational winter program. The winter season is held on eight consecutive Saturdays in January and February for children between 5 and 12 years old. This is a practice-free program.

Players who wish to participate in competitive play have the opportunity to play on Palos Verdes AYSO post-season teams starting at the 9U division. Coaches designated by our Tournament Committee form post-season teams that typically play from November through the following May. Each age division supports at least one boys' team and one girls' team. In 2016, we have over 30 teams from Palos Verdes AYSO participating in our post-season program.

As part of our post-season program, Palos Verdes AYSO hosts a Spring Select League that's played from early February through May each year. More than 1,500 players representing 115 teams from the greater South Bay area are playing in our 2017 Spring Select League.

AYSO Soccer Camps and Academy

In 2017, we will offer 6 weeks of AYSO Soccer Camps. These are very popular programs which had nearly 800 kids attend in 2016. Spring Camp will be in March/April. Summer Camps will be in June and August. A Winter break camp will be in December. We also offer a Fall Academy that will run on consecutive Sundays during our Fall season for those players that want more instruction than what a regular team will offer. We will continue the popular Spring Academy from March through May along with a program for 3-year-olds called Playtime Adventure that is parent participatory. All of these programs are taught by professional coaches that come here from England and other parts of Europe.

EXTRA Program

Our region participates in AYSO's EXTRA program where kids will try out for EXTRA teams and if chosen, will play in a side-by-side format with our Fall season against other EXTRA teams in other regions throughout Southern California.

Our Community

Each year we honor two worthy AYSO youth volunteers with our Jeff Rickel Memorial Scholarship. High school seniors who played in AYSO and who volunteered in our region are eligible to apply.

Our Region also supports Get Give Go!, as this family run group provides used uniforms and equipment to less fortunate children all over the world. We collect these items at our opening and closing days.

We Need You to Volunteer!

AYSO is an all-volunteer organization. More than 70 dedicated volunteers serve on the Region 10 board of directors and work year-round to organize fair and friendly AYSO soccer for the nearly 4,000 children who play in our fall, winter, spring, and summer programs in Palos Verdes at some time during the year. Each year, we rely on more than 800 volunteers to coach and to referee. The next time that you see a coach or referee on the field making this program possible for your child, please take a moment to acknowledge his or her efforts.
